Please note: Program staff will upload a copy of your document to a secure site through the City of Madison for verification. The City of Madison uses the federal SAVE system to verify eligibility.

Approved Documents

The following are approved enumerators and examples of corresponding documents to show legal status.

Not all forms containing approved enumerators are listed:

- **Social Security Number:** Found on a social security card.
- **Visa Number:** Also known as the visa foil number, the visa number is the red number printed on the bottom right of a **visa document**.
- **USCIS Number / A- Number:** Found on forms **N-550, N-570, N-560, N-561, N-551, I-327, I-571, I-766**, etc. If the A-number is less than nine digits, leading zeros must be included to make the A-number nine digits when submitting. Do not include the "A" when submitting the A-number for verification.
- **I-94 Number:** Found on Form **I-94 Arrival/Departure Record**.
- **Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) ID Number:** Unique identifier printed on Forms **I-20, DS-2019**, etc. Do not include the letter "N" when submitting the number.
- **Naturalization / Citizenship Certificate Number:** Found on forms **N-550, N-570, N-560, N-561**, etc.
- **Card / I-797 Receipt Number:** Found on **Permanent Resident Card (Form I-551)** or on the back and front of the **Employment Authorization Document (Form I-766)**.
- **Card Numbers:** Also referred to as document numbers. Printed on the back of the **Permanent Resident Card (Form I-551)** or on the back and front of the **Employment Authorization Document (Form I-766)**.
- **Receipt Numbers:** Found on **Form I-797, Notice of Action**.
- **Foreign Passport Number:** Although a foreign passport is not issued by the U.S., its information can sometimes be used to locate an applicant's records in the system.
